Driving to Camano Island:

From Seattle, drive north on Interstate 5 and take exit 212 west toward Camano Island.

Stay on this road and pass through Stanwood continue over the Camano Bridge to enter the island.

From Canada, Blaine or Bellingham, drive south on I-5 and take exit 212 west toward Camano Island.

Driving to South Whidbey:

From Seattle, drive north on Interstate 5 and take exit 182.

Keep left at the fork and merge onto WA-525 N. Follow Whidbey Island Ferry sign and catch Clinton-Mukilteo ferry.

No charge to the passenger to catch the Clinton-Mukilteo ferry, only to pay for the vehicles-
