Join new friends and old for a fun, relaxing social evening at the Musée Conti, New Orleans' famous historical wax museum. Built in 1890, "The WAX," as it is known, is a perfect example of turn of the century French Quarter architecture and offers a glimpse into the scandalous history of New Orleans. After your personal tour of the museum, you'll be invited to dine on a sumptuous feast of traditional Louisiana cuisine in the Legends Room while being serenaded by the light jazz sound of a local jazz trio. After dinner you'll have the opportunity to try your hand at poker, black jack or roulette tables for an opportunity to win a special prize.

Directions:

The venue is approximately 0.3 miles from the Ritz-Carlton at 917 Conti Street. It is a 5 minute walk from the hotel via Dauphine Street. If you have a disability and need assistance with transportation, please let a member of staff know in advance.

- From the front lobby of the hotel turn left on Canal Street towards Dauphine.
- Turn left on Dauphine and walk 3 blocks (0.2 miles)
- Turn left on Conti Street and the Museum will be on your right at 917 Conti Street.
