Polling and Social Q&A

To encourage you to participate fully in sessions, many speakers will be using a new interactivity tool this year. FMI and GMA are pleased to partner with Conferences i/o to bring you a new interactive web-based feature that will promote attendee engagement and participation at the conference and improve your learning experience. You can use a laptop, smartphone or tablet to participate. No username or password is required. Just go to www.fmi.cnf.io to participate or access the individual session links in our mobile app. You can answer polls set by the presenter. Some polls may already be active, so we encourage you to answer those ahead of time. Some will be unlocked during the session. In addition, you will see that you can ask the presenter questions either before, during or after the session. You'll also be able to see what other attendees are asking and "up-vote" that question so that it rises to the top. The presenter will then know what the audience is most interested in discussing. OPENING KEYNOTE SESSION – WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19, 4:30 - 6:00 PM *Grand Ballroom, Tower Building*

The 2015 FMI/GMA Global Sustainability Summit will begin with Dr. Cathie Woteki, Under Secretary for USDA's Research, Education, and Economics (REE) mission area and the Department's Chief Scientist. Prior to joining USDA, Dr. Woteki served as Global Director of Scientific Affairs for Mars, Incorporated, where she managed the company's scientific policy and research on matters of health, nutrition, and food safety. She has served as Dean of Agriculture and Professor of Human Nutrition at Iowa State University and was the first Under Secretary for Food Safety at the USDA where she oversaw U.S. Government food safety policy development and USDA's continuity of operations planning. Dr. Woteki served in the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy as Deputy Associate Director for Science. In 1999, Dr. Woteki was elected to the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences, where she has chaired the Food and Nutrition Board.
