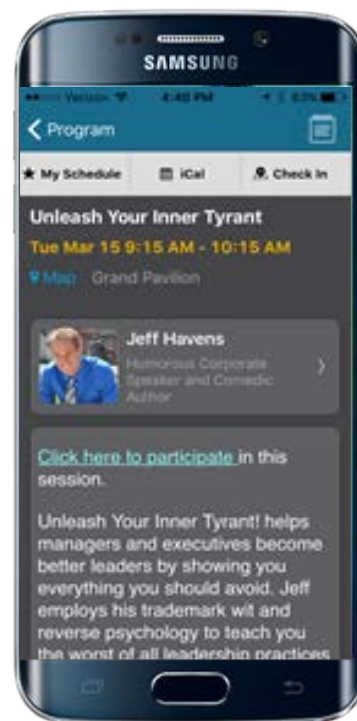
Meeting rooms are notorious for being somewhat chilly, so we advise you to bring layers to ensure your comfort. Morning temperatures will be in the 50's and rise to the 70s and 80s during the day. You are advised to bring a light jacket for evening functions that are held outside.

ATTENDEE PARTICIPATION (POLLING AND SOCIAL Q&A) [\[BACK TO INDEX\]](#)

Before and during the conference you will have access to an interactive web-based feature that will promote attendee engagement and participation at the conference and improve your learning experience.

You can use a laptop, smartphone or tablet to participate. No username or password is required. Just go to www.fmi2.cnf.io to participate or use the “*click here to participate*” link in the mobile app. Here you can click on the session and answer polls set by the presenter. Some polls may already be active, so we encourage you to answer those ahead of time. Some will be unlocked during the session.

In addition, you will see that you can ask the presenter questions either before, during or after the session. You'll also be able to see what other attendees are asking and “up-vote” that question so that it rises to the top. The presenter will then know what the audience is most interested in discussing. We hope you'll make good use of this tool!



BADGES [\[BACK TO INDEX\]](#)

Badges must be worn at all times and are mandatory for the offsite event. There are no exhibitor-only badges or one-day passes available. All spouses / guests attending the social functions must have a badge. FMI enforces a strict “no badge, no admittance” policy.

Players must be pre-registered for golf. There is no onsite registration

Location/Time: The golf tournament will take place at La Paloma Country Club (which is located on property at The Westin La Paloma Resort) on Monday, March 14th. Breakfast will be served starting at 6:45 a.m. in La Paloma Dining Room in the Club House. Practice facilities including the driving range, putting, and chipping areas will be open for participants interested in warming up. Players will be seated at 7:45 a.m. with a planned 8:00 a.m. Shotgun Start.

Daylight Savings Time: Reminder...Arizona DOES NOT observe daylight savings time, so the local time will not change while we are in Tucson.

Personal Golf Club Storage: If you would like the hotel to store your personal golf clubs for the tournament, please inform the front desk upon check-in at the hotel. The bell stand will store your clubs safely and have them transferred to the club house on Monday morning for you. Players who do not wish to store clubs at the bell stand will be responsible for transporting their own clubs to the golf course on Monday morning. After the tournament, all players are responsible for transporting personal clubs back to their guest room.

Rental Clubs: Clubs will be available to rent at the course pro shop. The cost of clubs is \$50.00 per set, inclusive of tax. If you have asked for rental clubs and are staying on property, the clubs will be set on your cart the morning of the tournament and will be billed to your guest room. Club house staff will collect your signature for the charge to your guest room prior to the tournament start.

Attire: All players must comply with the Club's dress code. A shirt with a collar is required. Shorts may be worn but must be at least mid-thigh in length and cannot be denim. Currently, the projected temperature being reported for the morning of Monday, March 14th is low-50s and sunny. Check the weather before you depart for Tucson and dress appropriately.

Following the tournament, lunch will be provided in La Paloma Dining Room in the Club House.

****Please note** there is a 24-hour resort shuttle system to transport guests around the resort property. Please allow at least 15 minutes for resort shuttle service.

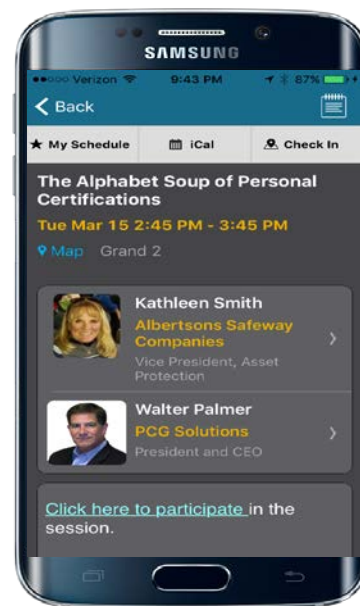
